Entry Criteria:

Must be able to provide a demo CD or DVD or Link of your performance music. A band registration fee \$25.00 is due day of performance. Bands that have a contract with a recording label do not qualify. Band registration fee due at sign in the day of the show Checks can be made out to the Lion Club. 50% of the band still must be in Middle or High School. Prizes:

Best band overall wins a performance on the 4th of July at the Lititz Spring Park on the main stage.

Second-place wins a gift certificate for the band

Third-place win a gift certificate for the band

Entry Deadline:

Entries must be submitted by May 1, 2010. Bands that are selected will be notified by May 5th.

Performance Details:

Bands selected for the competition will be assigned a 20 minute slot on Saturday May 15, 2010. We will require strict adherence to the time allotted. If a band is late for their performance, they will not be guaranteed performance time. Not starting or finishing at the required time may affect your overall score. No profanity words in the lyrics or during the performance. Appropriate substitutions words are permitted.

A sound system provided by Clair Brothers. All other musical equipment must be provided by the band.

Judging:

Judging will be conducted by a panel of judges familiar with the current music industry. Overall decisions of the judges will be based on scores in the categories of stage presence, creativity, instrumental excellence, vocal excellence, and audience involvement and professionalism. The audience involvement category will comprise of no more than 10% of the overall score.
